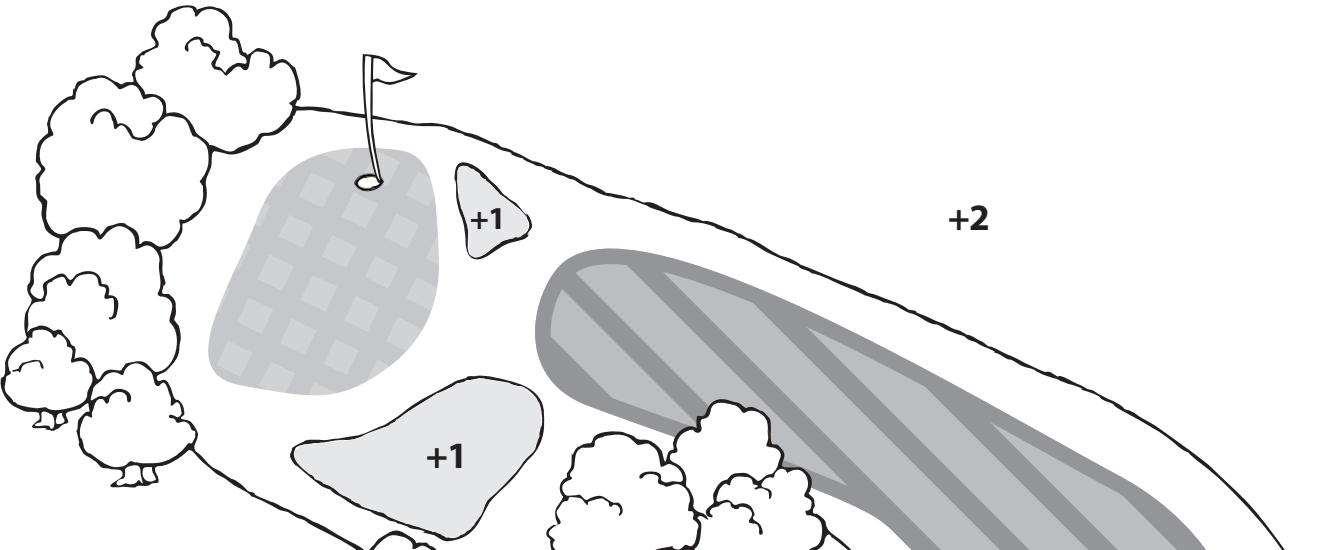


McCaddy Says...

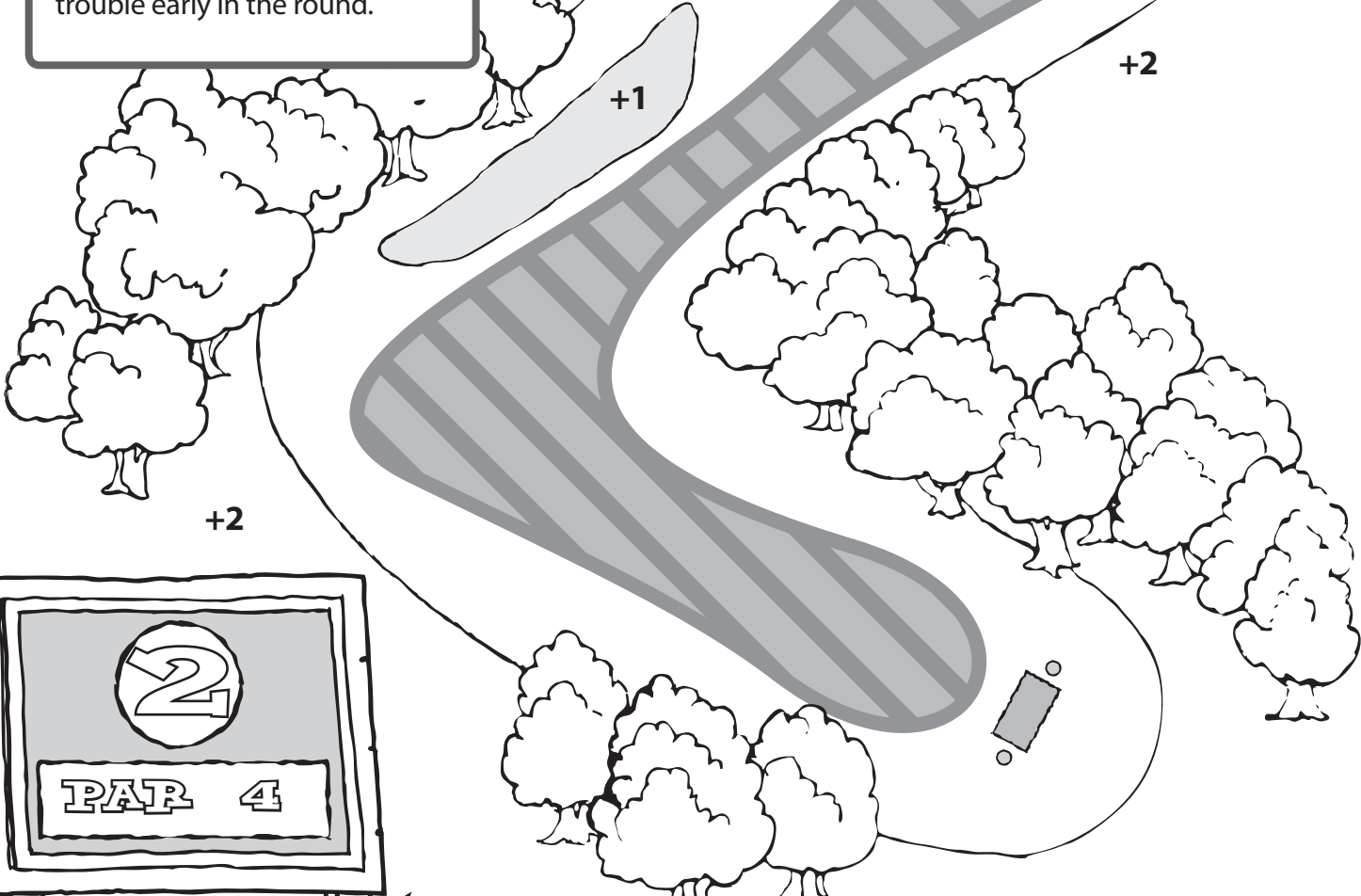
A fitting beginning to this championship course, **Garden Walk** is one of the most popular of the 18 holes. Play through this perfectly manicured tree-lined fairway to a gentle dog-leg left that opens to a straight shot to the green. If you can position your tee shot just past the middle trees you will have the best chance to get on in two.



McCaddy Says...

This exciting par four is affectionally known as the **Dog-Day**, after it's double dogleg design.

You can avoid the second dog-leg and even pick up a stroke by shooting the left chute to the green but be careful, if you don't make it you could find trouble early in the round.





McCaddy Says...

This unique par 4 is known as **Bumpers** because of the mess of trees scattered throughout the fairway. This one can be played so many ways you'll have to figure it out on your own! Practice, practice practice!
